- ◆ This is our 62nd year. Youth & Government is over 75 years old – held first in New York. The YMCA is over 150 years old.
- ◆ There are 2,350 anticipated number of delegates & advisors
- ◆ We have 74 participating YMCA Delegations.
- ◆ Oliver Mittelstaedt, South Pasadena San Marino, is our 62nd Youth Governor.

- ◆ 52 staff Interns were delegates who graduated last year or the year before.
- ◆ 90 of our volunteers are former delegates, some participated over 25 years ago.
- ◆ The average cost for each delegate to participate in the program is \$980.
- ◆ Our 2010 Annual Support Campaign fundraising goal is \$310,000.
- ◆ Annual support pledges may be paid by credit card!
- ◆ Youth & Government makes a difference – the results of a recent study found that YMCA Alumni are more likely to:

- ◆ \$135,000 in scholarships was awarded to delegates in need from the Governor Deukmejian Endowment Fund.
- ◆ Annually, we **rent** computers, printers, video equipment, screens, tables, chairs, trucks, vans, a very large tent, and garbage dumpsters.
- ◆ It costs more than \$2,000 at Kinkos to duplicate the court cases.
- ◆ We serve 26,500 meals at our two training conferences at Camp Roberts.
- ◆ This spring, we will hold our 10th Model United Nations Program for 6th, 7th & 8th graders in Burbank.
