MLC INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Y&G Intern Program is open to recent high school graduates looking to give back to the statewide program in meaningful and productive roles. Young adults between the ages of 18 and 21 are encouraged to apply for opportunities within the Model Legislature & Court Program. They will serve as Committee Advisors, Program Area assistants and/or Managers within the Intern Program itself.

Interns will participate in training sessions regarding youth mentorship, presentation skills, professional development (including resume and cover letter workshops) and more. When Interns are not serving the program or polishing their leadership abilities, they're having fun! In fact, the Intern Program is a great platform for young adults entering the academic and professional world to foster long-lasting friendships with others around the state and beyond.

WHAT DO Y&G INTERNS DO?

Most new Y&G Interns are placed within a group of Forum delegates to serve as a Committee Advisors to help lead a Forum committee through their bill writing process. In later years, Interns are placed within other program areas to learn more about the program. Placement is determined by interest and experience.

WHAT'S EXPECTED OF ME IF I BECOME AN INTERN?

This is a commitment. Once you're accepted into the Intern Program, we're relying on you. Attendance is required at all Y&G conferences and the Intern retreat (date & location TBA). During conferences, Y&G will cover the cost of your hotel and meals. Transportation to conferences will be your own responsibility.

As Y&G will book hotel reservations in your name, you must also submit a \$100 refundable attendance deposit. This deposit will be refunded once the program year as been completed and you have attended all conferences. You will not be asked to submit payment until you have been accepted as an Intern.
